Why Pathfinder Exists

Pathfinder Therapy CIC exists to improve access to meaningful psychological support, particularly for veterans, military families and adults navigating trauma, transition, loss, identity change and life changing adversity.

Veteran Leadership

Pathfinder is led by therapists and veterans. Lived experience of service, injury, transition and recovery informs the organisation while clinical governance, professional standards and safeguarding remain central to delivery.

Armed Forces Covenant Commitment

As an Armed Forces Covenant signatory, Pathfinder recognises the contribution of serving personnel, reservists, veterans and military families and is committed to ensuring they are not disadvantaged when accessing support.

Impact & Outcomes

Pathfinder is developing an outcomes framework covering access, clinical safety, client experience, veteran engagement, community benefit and future project development.
